

Station 6: What's Next

- Your input will be reviewed and incorporated into the process to help identify a range of possible routes.
- The range of routes will be presented at a second public meeting in fall 2009. Watch for your invitation.
- The range of routes will be evaluated using regulatory, engineering and community criteria.
- The routes developed in the Community Advisory Process that meet all siting criteria will be included in Idaho Power's revised application to the Bureau of Land Management and U.S. Forest Service.
- These agencies will then proceed with a review under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). The Oregon Department of Energy/Energy Facility Siting Council (EFSC) will also proceed with a thorough review.
- Idaho Power will continue to keep communities updated and informed during these reviews.
